MAKING YOUR PICKS

To complete the ballot correctly, rank each nominee in all 20 categories in order of most likely to win (1) to least likely to win (5). Most categories have five nominees, however some have three and one has ten. In these categories rank the nominees from (1) to (3) and (1) to (10) accordingly.

DETERMINING SCORES

When a category winner is announced, the number you assigned to that nominee is your score for that category. For example: if *Old Dogs* were to win "Worst Picture" and you assigned it a "3," your "Worst Picture" score would be "3". Record that score in the box next to the title heading. It's not rocket

science, people. But, if you need a more visual example, see the the diagram below.

DETERMINING A WINNER

The owner of the ballot with the lowest total score will be the winner. In the event of a tie the ballot with the most correct 1st place picks will be the winner. If these scores are identical, 2nd place picks will determine the winner, with 3rd place picks being the next tie-breaker and so on. If more than 30 entries are received, the owners of the best two ballots will divide the total pot (with 2/3 going to the best ballot and 1/3 going to the second-best ballot). If fewer than 30 entries are received the entire pot will go to the owner of the best ballot.
